**Rottweiler Puppy Naming**

DKV's litter letter determines the first initial of Rottweiler's call name. The litter letter is " \_\_\_\_\_ ". The AKC registration allows fifteen characters for the call name. This Rottweiler's AKC registered name will be \_\_\_\_\_ Von Der **Korperkraft**. If a name is not provided to the Breeder by 7 weeks of age, Breeder will name said Rottweiler. Purchaser understands no other kennel name may be added. Purchaser also understands the above AKC registered name cannot be changed. If Purchaser changes the above AKC registered name, contract is automatically null and void, and Purchaser provides permission for Breeder to contact AKC and have the name changed back to the agreed name above.

Once sale is final and Purchaser receives said Rottweiler, Breeder automatically transfers all wellbeing and financial responsibility of said Rottweiler to Purchaser, this includes all unforeseen costs due to illness or injury. Purchaser agrees to take full responsibility for all damages and injuries caused by said Rottweiler throughout its lifetime with the Purchaser, to both property and people, including death. Furthermore, the Purchaser fully releases all responsibility from the Breeder, for damage or injury caused or received by said Rottweiler on and after the date of transfer, \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 20\_\_\_\_.

Purchaser agrees to take proper safeguards for the care and safety of said Rottweiler including, but not limited to, the following items: Providing proper shelter, an enclosed exercise area, fresh water daily, fresh food daily, daily exercise, early socialization, basic obedience, yearly medical exam by a licensed veterinarian, full liability of all medical bills incurred throughout Rottweiler's lifetime, and a lifetime of love.

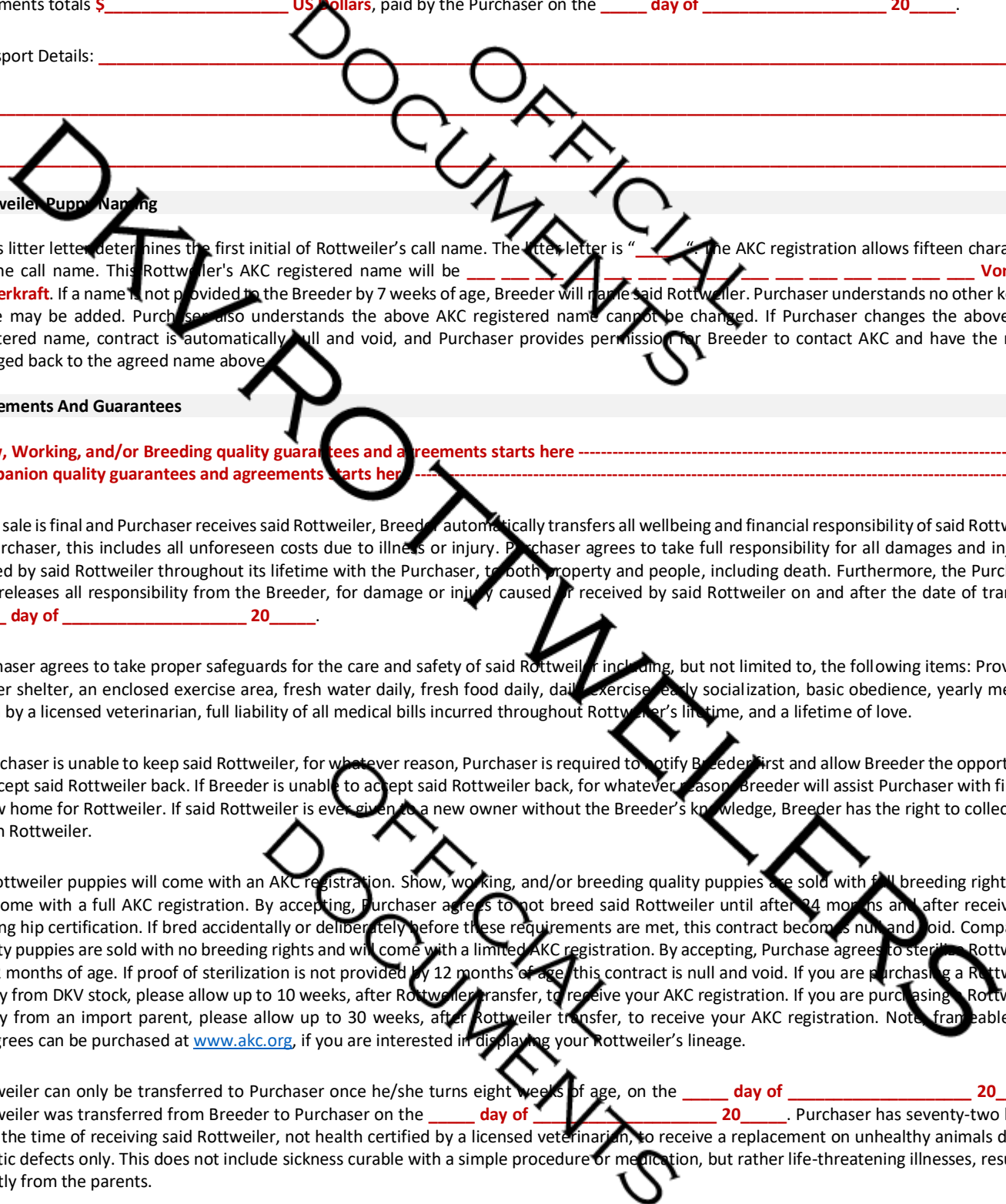
If Purchaser is unable to keep said Rottweiler, for whatever reason, Purchaser is required to notify Breeder first and allow Breeder the opportunity to accept said Rottweiler back. If Breeder is unable to accept said Rottweiler back, for whatever reason, Breeder will assist Purchaser with finding a new home for Rottweiler. If said Rottweiler is ever given to a new owner without the Breeder's knowledge, Breeder has the right to collect and retain Rottweiler.

All Rottweiler puppies will come with an AKC registration. Show, working, and/or breeding quality puppies are sold with full breeding rights and will come with a full AKC registration. By accepting, Purchaser agrees to not breed said Rottweiler until after 24 months and after receiving a passing hip certification. If bred accidentally or deliberately before these requirements are met, this contract becomes null and void. Companion quality puppies are sold with no breeding rights and will come with a limited AKC registration. By accepting, Purchase agrees to sterilize Rottweiler by 12 months of age. If proof of sterilization is not provided by 12 months of age, this contract is null and void. If you are purchasing a Rottweiler puppy from DKV stock, please allow up to 10 weeks, after Rottweiler transfer, to receive your AKC registration. If you are purchasing a Rottweiler puppy from an import parent, please allow up to 30 weeks, after Rottweiler transfer, to receive your AKC registration. Note: frameable AKC pedigrees can be purchased at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org), if you are interested in displaying your Rottweiler's lineage.

Rottweiler can only be transferred to Purchaser once he/she turns eight weeks of age, on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 20\_\_\_\_. Purchaser has seventy-two hours from the time of receiving said Rottweiler, not health certified by a licensed veterinarian, to receive a replacement on unhealthy animals due to genetic defects only. This does not include sickness curable with a simple procedure or medication, but rather life-threatening illnesses, resulting directly from the parents.

All Rottweiler puppies will be examined at 7 weeks of age by a licensed veterinarian, before they are transferred to Purchaser. Exam includes weight, temperature, visual exam of coat, skin, ears, eyes, belly, heart check for murmur, and fecal test for worms and parasites. Please understand, the Breeder is not a licensed veterinarian. The Breeder does not assume any puppy is healthy until issued a health certificate by a

licensed veterinarian. If a licensed veterinarian issues a health certificate, this means the puppy was thoroughly examined, passed multiple health exams, and was deemed healthy by that licensed veterinarian. If any health issues are found, they will be discussed in detail with Purchaser before puppy is transferred. Were any health issues found by a licensed veterinarian on said puppy? Diagnosed congenital heart defects are guaranteed up to 24 months of age, if and only if, it is the direct result of an early death before 24 months of age. To enforce this guarantee, a proper diagnosis by a cardiac specialist is required. This includes two echo exams, six months apart, to properly diagnose. Proper diagnosis is required because it is very common for young puppies, especially large breed puppies, to develop an innocent heart murmur while they are growing rapidly. The murmur may first appear at 2-3 months of age, and a puppy with an innocent heart murmur will usually outgrow it by about 5-6 months of age. This type of murmur is benign (not harmful). In general, a physiologic or innocent heart murmur will have a low intensity (usually Grade I-II out of VI) and does not cause any symptoms or clinical signs. Understanding heart murmurs is important since there is a very large difference between an innocent growth murmur and a congenital heart murmur. If a congenital heart murmur is diagnosed by a cardiac specialist, copies of all medical records are required to be sent to Breeder within 30 days of diagnosis. If the diagnosed murmur is then the result of an early death, Breeder will approve a replacement Rottweiler to Purchaser. Purchaser is required to send all documents from all licensed veterinarians and licensed cardiac specialist, proving and attesting to this fact, to the Breeder via postal mail or e-mail. Only once these steps are performed will the Breeder approve a replacement Rottweiler. Replacement Rottweiler will be of equal quality, determined by the Breeder, and will be transferred as soon as one is available, not exceeding 24 months.

**Companion quality guarantees and agreements and here**-----

Breeder guarantees this show, working, and/or breeding quality Rottweiler from any disqualifying fault to the show ring according to the AKC Rottweiler standards, other than disqualifying for lameness or temperament until 24 months of age. This does not include cherry eye, minimal white hairs, or visible undercoat, as these are not disqualifying faults and/or can be corrected. If said Rottweiler becomes less quality than guaranteed and actively competes in the AKC show ring, attending more than 6 shows per year (proof of critiques required), Breeder will provide half credit of said Rottweiler's full purchase price to the Purchaser, that can be used towards a future Rottweiler purchase from DKV Rottweilers only. This credit will remain active for as long as DKV Rottweilers remains in business. Purchaser is required to send all documents from the licensed professional Rottweiler judge or handler, proving and attesting to this fact, to the Breeder via postal mail or e-mail. Purchaser is to then spay, or neuter said Rottweiler, provide proof of sterilization from a licensed veterinarian to the Breeder, and keep said Rottweiler as a companion. Only once these steps are performed will the half credit of the purchase price be credited to Purchaser.

Breeder guarantees show, working, and/or breeding quality Rottweiler hips until the age of 26 months, only if both parents are not hip certified. New studies have finally shown that the cause of hip dysplasia is eighty percent environmental, and only twenty percent genetic. That being said, it is extremely important to take extra care of your Rottweiler's hips the first 18 months of life. This is when the bones are most soft and still rapidly growing. To help protect your Rottweiler, do not allow your Rottweiler to slide on slippery floors such as tile, ride in the back bed of a truck, do any kind of training that requires your Rottweiler to jump higher than his/her height, or run excessively on hard surfaces such as concrete. These preventable activities are proven to cause hip dysplasia in young Rottweilers. To enforce our hip guarantee, Purchaser is required to have said Rottweiler x-rayed as a youth, between ten and twelve months of age. Note, if your Rottweiler is female, it is very important to not have hips x-rayed near their heat cycle, as this can negatively impact the results. The purchaser is then required to have the Rottweiler officially x-rayed at the age of twenty-four months by a veterinarian who has experience taking OFA x-rays. Note, proper placement can mean the difference between passing or failing. If the x-ray at twenty-four months does not look like it will pass OFA (according to your licensed Veterinarian or Radiologist), it is not to be submitted to OFA. A second x-ray is to be done by a licensed Veterinarian of the Breeders choice, at the Purchaser's expense, or the hips will not be guaranteed. The best x-ray will then be submitted to OFA, or another agreed on hip registering organization. If said Rottweiler does not receive a result of Borderline or higher, Breeder will provide half credit of said Rottweiler's full purchase price to the Purchaser, that can be used towards a future Rottweiler purchase from DKV Rottweilers only. This credit will remain active for as long as DKV Rottweilers remains in business. Purchaser is required to send all documents from the licensed veterinarian, proving and attesting to this fact, to the Breeder via postal mail or e-mail. Purchaser is to then spay, or neuter said Rottweiler, provide proof of sterilization from a licensed veterinarian to the Breeder, and keep said Rottweiler as a companion. Only once these steps are performed will the half credit of the purchase price be credited to Purchaser.
